- Case Study: Calculating the cost of a new product introduction (NPI) and identifying the cost-saving potential of substituting a high-cost raw material using BOM cost roll-up.

Module 7: BOM and Material Requirements Planning (MRP)

- Understanding the BOM's role as input for MRP and capacity planning.
- Executing an MRP run and analyzing its output for planned orders.
- Managing lead times, scrap factors, and yield rates in the BOM for accurate planning.
- Utilizing BOM data for Forecasting and Safety Stock calculation.
- Case Study: Resolving a persistent material shortage issue by correcting BOM-related lead times and scrap factors in the ERP's MRP configuration.

Module 8: Data Governance and Best Practices

- Establishing BOM Data Governance policies and organizational roles.
- Ensuring Data Quality and integrity through validation and auditing.
- Best practices for BOM creation, maintenance, and distribution.
- Leveraging ERP workflows for digital collaboration and approval cycles.
- Case Study: Implementing a cross-functional BOM review process to eliminate historical data entry errors and improve first-pass quality in a medical device firm.
