12. Recognize how SCM processes integrate with Dynamics 365 Finance and other ERP Systems.
13. Analyze existing supply chain processes and identify opportunities for Advanced Automation within D365 SCM.

- Case Study: Using a Quarantine Order process for a defective batch of received goods and triggering a subsequent vendor quality report.

- Accessing and customizing Power BI dashboards for SCM.
- Overview of integration points with D365 Finance and external systems
- Introduction to Security Roles and permission sets for SCM users.
- Case Study: Building a custom filter on the Inventory on-hand report to monitor Safety Stock levels across specific warehouses.
