Course Introduction

In an era of rapid digital transformation and evolving algorithmic management, the mandate for trade union governance has shifted from traditional advocacy to a complex model of institutional resilience and tripartite social dialogue. Governance and Accountability in Trade Unions Training Course provides the strategic framework necessary for union leaders to align their operations with international ILO conventions and domestic legal standards, ensuring that the spirit of solidarity is backed by robust accountability mechanisms.

The training moves beyond basic administrative oversight to address the twin transitions of green and digital skills, framing governance infrastructure as a "capability intervention" (Hew, 2026). By integrating transformational leadership styles with rigorous public financial management (PFM) principles, participants will learn to mitigate risks such as information asymmetry, resource scarcity, and internal disunity (Gautam, 2026; Kithuri, 2025). Ultimately, this program empowers union officials to co-create institutions that are transparent, democratically accountable, and capable of delivering pro-worker collective bargaining agreements (CBAs) in a competitive global economy.

1. Establish a high-leverage governance infrastructure to protect rights-based digital governance
2. Master transformational leadership to enhance employee engagement and union morale
3. Implement fiscal discipline and operational efficiency using data-driven decision-making.
4. Navigate the legal framework of tripartite agreements involving government and employers.
5. Enhance transparency for members through open communication and digital access.
6. Utilize structural equation modeling concepts to track the impact of leadership on union density.
7. Integrate servant leadership to foster empathy and ethical conduct within the executive board.
8. Modernize collective bargaining frameworks to reach the 80% coverage target in line with EU directives.
9. Mitigate occupational safety and health (OSH) risks associated with algorithmically managed work.
10. Reduce information asymmetry between union leadership and the shop floor.
11. Apply alternative dispute resolution (ADR) to resolve internal splits and rivalry.
12. Design portable skills recognition systems as part of union-led training initiatives.
13. Leverage AI-driven analytics for monitoring the use of union funds and infrastructure.
